



2012 Camping Rules & Regulations

Thank you for camping with us! We look forward to having you stay with us and want to make sure you have a safe and memorable time. Please review the following rules and regulations to ensure that you and other Speedway guests are as comfortable as possible here at our facility.

Charlotte Motor Speedway is a family based organization and has a zero tolerance policy for public drunkenness, use of illegal drugs, lewd behavior and violence - verbal or physical - anywhere on Speedway property. Please know that Charlotte Motor Speedway Public Safety Officers, in conjunction with the Cabarrus County Sheriff's Department and City of Concord Police Department, monitor activity across Speedway property. Your cooperation with the CMS Public Safety Officers and local authorities is essential in ensuring your safety and allowing a normal flow of pedestrian and vehicular traffic. Failure to comply may result in expulsion from the facility permanently.

Please remember to be careful!

You are responsible for your own safety. Look out for natural hazards and dangers especially when you are in wooded areas. Swimming is not permitted in any of the ponds, streams or rivers located on or near the property of Charlotte Motor Speedway. If you hike off trails, wander in the woods or enter any body of water, do so AT YOUR OWN RISK.

The following rules are for ALL outer campgrounds, unless specifically noted.

- Outer Campground Entrance Dates: **All-Star Race - Monday, May 14th thru Monday, May 21st
Coca-Cola 600 -Monday, May 21st thru Monday, May 28th**
- Quiet time is enforced from 12 midnight until 7:00am.
- Campers are requested to turn generators off from 12 midnight until 7:00am.
- Please be aware of all carbon monoxide dangers that can be harmful to you or other guests. Vehicle and generator exhaust **MUST** be expelled safely into roadways and not into adjacent campsites.
 - Anyone needing a generator for health issues must check in with the Campground Check in Trailer and speak with the Campground Hosts. Anyone requesting exception to this rule must have an approved "exhaust flow pipe" attached their generator exhaust to vent the fumes upward and away from other campers in order to lessen the dangers of carbon monoxide. This would apply to motor homes and units with very low decibel generators.
 - Units with high decibel generators or no exhaust flow pipe will be moved to another location in the campground by the Campground Hosts and Speedway security so as not to disturb other campers, keep them awake, and maintain safety for all.
- All motorized vehicles must have a valid state license plate. No golf carts, motorized bikes, skateboards, scooters, etc. are permitted in the above campgrounds.
- Camping is permitted in designated campground spaces only. Vehicle and camping equipment must not extend beyond assigned space.
- No overnight camping is permitted in open parking areas.
- No box or cube trucks or oversized flatbed trucks will be permitted.
- Parking sticker/validation credential must be affixed to windshield at all times.
- One camping unit and one vehicle per site, unless the site is approved for dual parking by the Campground Hosts.
- Units must be parked with the front end exposed. Officials must be able to remove any unit immediately in case of an emergency. No units permitted to park in an L-shape, U-shape, etc.
- Fires are only allowed if contained in an above ground approved container. Please note for Infield Camping Only: No fires or fire rings. No grilling or fires of any kind during race activities.
- No firearms, dangerous weapons, or fireworks permitted as specified by local authorities.

- Please place trash in receptacles or trash bags. There will be one round of trash pick-up at each campground per day. Please note for Tom Johnson Racing Resort Only: A dumpster is available to use at your convenience.
- Please do not wash vehicles or RVs during your stay.
- Photo ID must accompany camping credential and be presented when requested by Charlotte Motor Speedway officials/employees.
- Drink responsibly; openly displayed alcoholic beverages are not permitted in our Hellmann's Family Campground.

NO UNAUTHORIZED MARKETING

The users of this camping space are prohibited from conducting commerce or engaging in any marketing activities. This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, the sale of goods, sampling, signage, surveying, food vending or any other activity that in the sole discretion of the staff of Charlotte Motor Speedway is deemed detrimental to the facility. Violation of this policy will result in forfeiture of the camping space and any monies paid. Camping spaces may also not be used for advertising, promotion (including contests or sweepstakes) or trade purposes without the express written consent of Charlotte Motor Speedway.

PET POLICY

Pets **are not** permitted in the grandstand areas during race event. Campers **are** allowed to bring the family pet when visiting campgrounds at Charlotte Motor Speedway. To insure the safety and enjoyment of all guests and campers, it is important that you read and abide by the following Pet Policy:

1. Aggressive dogs of any breed cannot enter or stay at CMS campgrounds. If your dog shows behavior that is protective and unfriendly to strangers, please leave it home. If you decide to bring your dog and it exhibits this type of behavior, CMS personnel will ask you to leave.
2. All dogs must be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times. A **leash rule** is in effect whenever the animal is outside the owner's camping trailer, vehicle, motorhome or tent – **there are no exceptions**. No dog can be left tied up and unattended outside the owner's camping equipment.
3. Campers must clean up after their pets and properly dispose of the waste; this rule applies at all times no matter where the pets relieve themselves in the campgrounds or parking areas. Please do not walk your pet through another camper's site or allow them to relieve themselves on someone else's site.
4. Allowing your pet to bark uncontrollably day or night will not be permitted and in such event you may be asked to leave.

Service dogs are always welcome at all CMS campgrounds. However, these animals must follow leash restraint policies and may not exhibit aggressive behavior.

Infield Specific Camping Rules and Regulations

- Infield Entrance Dates: **All-Star Race - Wednesday, May 16th thru Sunday, May 20th**
Coca-Cola 600 – Wednesday, May 23rd thru Monday, May 28th
- Scaffolding and flag height restrictions:
 - South Infield (Turns 1 & 2) 8 feet maximum
 - Tents, Vans, and very small campers only
 - North Infield (Turns 3 & 4) 12 feet maximum
 - RVs only (Tents allowed only in specified area during All Star weekend)
- All fans and visitors must have an infield credential/wristband which must be displayed at all times and subject to inspection for re-entry.
- Grandstand tickets are not acceptable for admission into the infield.
- No wagon races or other reckless activity that could cause serious injury are permitted.
