



Camping Check-in/Check-out Times

Camping World Racing Resort, Turn 4, Turn 1:

- Check-in begins Monday, May 20th at 1PM
- Check-out is Monday, May 27th by 12PM

Infield Camping:

- Wednesday, May 22nd from 1PM 9PM
- Thursday, May 23rd from 9AM 9PM
- Friday, May 24th from 9AM 9PM
- Saturday, May 25th from 9AM 9PM
- Sunday, May 26th from 9AM 6PM
- Check-out is Monday, May 27th by 12PM

General Camping Policies

- Quiet Hours: 12AM 7AM
- Car Passes must be visible at all times and affixed on the rearview mirror of the vehicle at all times. Infield Car Passes must be affixed to the front windshield of the vehicle.
- One camping unit and one vehicle per site is permitted, unless the site is approved for dual parking by the campground host.
- All campers must be able to tow their camping unit at any time.
- No pools over 2 feet tall are allowed. If a pool is put on your site, it must be on the gravel and not in the grass. Any pool may be deemed unacceptable at CMS employees' discretion
- Trash must be placed in a receptacle or trash bag. Place your trash at the end of the campsite or in the dumpster, there will be one round of trash pickup at each campground per day.
- You will be held responsible for any damages to the campsite during your stay. This
 includes but is not limited to fences, pedestals, gravel, roadway, road signs, and picnic
 tables.
- Verbal abuse towards our security or campground staff is not tolerated. Offenders will be asked to leave, and we reserve the right to deny site renewal.
- You are responsible for the guests at your campsite, if guests break campground rules you will be at risk of losing your right to renew.
- Pets are allowed at all campgrounds at Charlotte Motor Speedway.

- Pets must remain leashed whenever the animal is outside. No dogs can be left tied up and unattended outside the owners camping unit.
- Aggressive dogs of any breed cannot enter or stay at CMS campgrounds. If your dog exhibits this behavior, CMS personnel will ask you to leave.
- Pet pens are allowed but the pet must remain under supervision at all times.
- o Campers must pick up after their pets and properly dispose of waste.
- Service dogs are always allowed at all CMS campgrounds.
- Please be aware of carbon monoxide dangers that can be harmful to you or other guests. Vehicle and generator exhaust must be expelled safely into roadways and not into adjacent campsites. An exhaust flow pipe is required to be attached to the generator exhaust to vent the fumes upward and away from other campers in order to lessen the dangers of carbon monoxide.
- Prohibited Items:
 - Personal golf carts, low speed vehicles, ATV's/UTV's, motorized skateboards, etc.
 - Flags, signage or displays using profanity, vulgarity or sexually explicit imagery.
 - Displays of the confederate flag.
 - Firearms
 - Fireworks

Camping World Racing Resort-Specific Policies

- RV's are only allowed in this area, no tents.
- A bath house is on the property and located in front of the ZMax Dragway.
- Fires are only allowed if contained in an above ground container. Please dispose of all embers, embers may not be left on site upon departure.
- Sewer adaptors are mandatory and required to hook up to the septic system.
- Early arrivals at the campground beyond the scheduled event camping period require reservations in advance through the Charlotte Motor Speedway Camping Office. An additional fee will be applicable for extending stays beyond the event camping duration.

Geico Turn 1-Specific Policies

- RV's are only allowed in this area, no tents.
- A bath house is located in front of the Geico Family Campground.
- Fires are only allowed if contained in an above ground container. Please dispose of all embers, embers may not be left on site upon departure.

Geico Turn 4 Family-Specific Policies

- A bath house is on property and located at the front of the campground.
- Openly displayed alcoholic beverages are not permitted.
- Fires are only allowed if contained in an above ground container. Please dispose of all embers, embers may not be left on site upon departure.
 - Use of pallets for fire is prohibited.

Infield-Specific Policies

- All fans must have an infield wristband for entry and must be work/displayed at all times.
- 2 bath houses are located on the property (North and South Infield).
- Vehicle roofs and/or standing platforms are subject to height restrictions.
 - o 10 feet maximum for the South Infield (Turns 1 & 2).
 - o 13.5 feet maximum for the North Infield (Turn 3 & 4).
 - Charlotte Motor Speedway and NASCAR race control reserve the right to require any customer to lower and/or remove their campsite equipment.
- Firewood, fire rings, glass containers, or campfires are not permitted.
- No grilling of any kind when cars are on the track.
- One camping unit and one vehicle is permitted per site.
 - All RV sites will receive 1 pass for the camping unit and 1 pass for the tow vehicle. All tent sites will receive 1 pass for the tow vehicle.
- During the camping check-in process, guests will be asked to stay in their vehicle for pre-screening. Camping passes will be given to you when you reach the designated check-in point.
 - The pre-screening process includes a brief security search of your RV and/or vehicle. Security will be looking for items that are not allowed in the campgrounds including, but not limited to, weapons, fireworks and off-highway vehicles.
- Each camping space is tailored for a specific type of camping unit; only tents are permitted in tent spaces, while only campers are allowed in camper spaces. Failure to adhere to this requirement will result in eviction from the site.
