



TRAILER RACE RULES

GENERAL EVENT OBJECTIVE

The intent of this event is good, cheap, fun competition. Competitors making it more than that by spending undue amounts of time and/or money on vehicle preparation will be discouraged from competing.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Any full-size tow vehicle is allowed, cars, ¾ ton or less pickup trucks, SUV's, vans, etc. NO CONVERTIBLES.
2. Front wheel drive or rear wheel drive only, NO FOUR-WHEEL DRIVES.
3. Tow vehicles must be stripped of all glass.
 - a. Screen/plexiglass must be used in place of windshield.
4. Tow vehicles must be stripped of all flammable material (rugs, headliners, door panels, bottom of rear seat, etc.)
5. All parts must be factory stocked.
6. All exterior lights and body moldings must be removed.
7. Driver's door must be welded shut AND painted orange.
 - a. If hit in the door you will be disqualified.
8. NO lift kits or suspension alterations allowed.
9. NO air bags, if vehicle has an airbag it must be disconnected.
10. Batteries must remain in stock location and be securely fastened.
11. Tow vehicle must display a one or two-digit number the full height of the door on each side of the car for identification purposes.
12. Roll cage or roll protection is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age.
2. NO passengers allowed.
3. All drivers MUST attend the pre-race drivers meeting.
4. Drivers must sign liability waiver.

TRAILER ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum trailer length 10 feet measured from hitch ball socket.
2. Suggestions are travel trailers, pop-up tent campers and boat trailers.
 - a. Pop-up trailers must be raced in the fully extended popped-up position.
 - b. Boat trailers must have a boat and the boat must be secured to the trailer.
 - c. NO excessive screws or nails can be used.
3. Glass must be removed from tow object.

4. Campers must be completely cleaned out inside, removing everything that is not a part of the unit.
 - a. Pots and pans, clothes, silverware, trash, household items or anything that is not a permanent part of trailer.
5. Boats must be gutted.
 - a. NO motors, fuel tanks, or out drives allowed.
6. Mascots, decorating vehicles, advertising nicknames, cartoons, etc. are encouraged.
 - a. Anything on the vehicle in bad taste will mean disqualification.
 - b. NO suggestive language or symbols allowed on vehicles.

DRIVER PROTECTION

1. Helmets are required.
2. Fire suits are highly recommended.
3. Seatbelts are mandatory.
4. Keep seatbelts and helmets on at all times.
5. Do not leave cockpit of tow vehicle, unless on fire or instructed to do so by track official.
6. Each competitor is solely responsible for the effectiveness of personal safety equipment used during an event. Charlotte Motor Speedway is not responsible for the effectiveness of any personal safety equipment.
7. RACEviers will be provided for one way communication with control tower.

EVENT RULES

1. Oval style track.
2. 12 minute race, no laps counted.
3. Last vehicle with object AND frame still attached wins.
 - a. In case of multiple vehicles having objects AND frame still attached after 12 minutes, a tie-breaker drag race will determine winner.
4. If your object falls off BUT trailer frame is still attached, continue racing. BUT you are ineligible to participate in potential tie-break drag race.
5. If trailer frame completely detaches from tow vehicle, then you are disqualified from the race.
6. Participants merely racing around the track trying to avoid contact will be disqualified.
7. NO vehicle-to-vehicle hits, must hit trailer.
